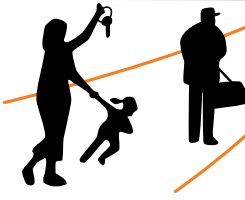

The community meeting process began six days after the first Bring LA Home Partners meeting held on November 13, 2003.

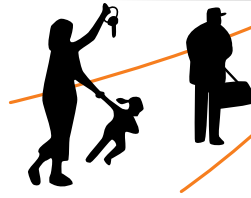

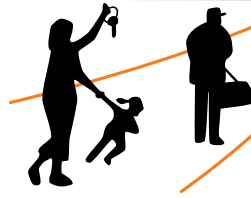

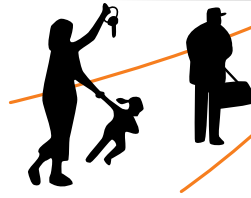

Status Report on Letter of Inquiry to Public City and County Agencies About Homelessness

February 3, 2004

Following the Blue Ribbon Panel's approval of a letter of inquiry to Los Angeles city and county agencies about homelessness at its last meeting, letters were sent to 244 public sector agencies. Responses were requested by January 29, 2004.

As of February 2, 2004, responses have been received from 31 organizations for an overall response rate of 14 percent. Police departments have had the highest rate of response, and city managers the lowest rate, as shown in the table below.

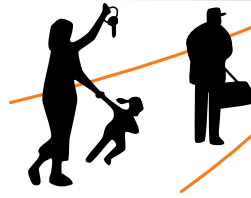

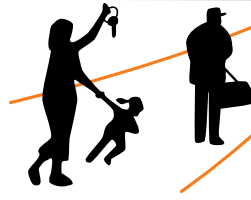

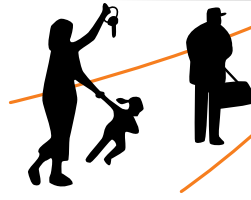
